Administrative history / Biographical sketch

Note

Joseph Stanley Goldbloom (1932-2022) was a political advisor in New York, New York serving Southeast Queens. He was the son of Ruth and A. A. Goldbloom, MD (New York Medical College), and the grandson of Fannie and I. W. Held, MD (Beth Israel Hospital). He studied government at Wesleyan University and Columbia University and was an active member in the Masons.

Scope and content

This material was collected by Joseph Goldbloom, grandson of I. W. Held. It includes two boxes of personal papers of I.W. Held, MD, including photographs, correspondence, reprints, and lectures and pamphlets related to the annual I. W. Held lecture series given at Beth Israel Medical Center. These materials provide insight into the life of Dr. Held and his impact on Beth Israel. Additionally, the collection reveals much about the life of a World War II-era Jewish family of doctors living on the Upper East Side of New York City. There are also unprocessed materials in this collection. One box of materials A. Allen Goldbloom, MD (father of Joseph Goldbloom), as it pertains to his medical career. Additionally, there are a significant number of 16mm films in this collection. These were largely taken by A. Allen Goldbloom documenting family vacations in Northeastern United States and Europe. A much smaller number were created by I. W. Held and other family members. These materials are pending processing and transfer to a more appropriate repository.

Notes

Physical condition

All films will need to be digitized prior to access due to conservation concerns.

Arrangement

This collection was received with no notable original order, and the arrangement was imposed by the archivist. These materials have been arranged in rough chronological order. Photographs and bound volumes respectively have been grouped together.
