Telegrams will be the explanation.

I have taken the liberty though of examining

my

undoubted brain symptoms. Pupils dilated
and slow in responding to light. Uncon-

sciousness: Meningitic marks very
distinct on the skin, on genitalia -
operculae. Slight tremor.

Adapt: Anstipkin, scanty urine (5 copious),
there is little sighing, and only once yesterday,
no vomiting. No slow pulse now, no inter-

mittence (120), no retardation of respiration
(on the contrary 28). Disproportion speaking

against primary brain disease, but for
primary pulmonary disease. Percussion

sound dull on right side, but resp
murmur on that side distinct though diminished

When I have not seen, it would
be worth while to look for nephritis.
Probably the Secondary ~~hypertension~~
itis has lasted for some time, and
originated in the pulmonary complaint.
It may be tubercular men. of the
surface; the base being intact,
or mostly so.

I should propose to get him under
the influence of both Iodine and
Hydr. the latter inebriately,
perhaps $\frac{1}{4}$ th or $\frac{1}{3}$ rd of a grain
daily. KI in large doses, say 10 or
15 grains every 2 hours. Prognosis
bad, it is true, but still - who can
tell. The secondary affections give
a chance. Very truly yrs
